




DEVINE STREET LOCATION



PERIODONTICS is the field of dentistry concerned with the support of your teeth, discomfort or longstanding infection. We also replace missing teeth with implants. Often periodontal disease does not hurt and many patients are not aware they have a problem - although bleeding or swollen gum tissue, foul breath or taste, sensitive and loose teeth may all be present to varying degrees. Often, none of these symptoms are present. Periodontal disease can move rapidly and you can get worse between dental check-ups. About three out of four adults will be affected by it at some point in their lives. Surprisingly, it is the number one cause of tooth loss in individuals over the age of 35.

OUR PHILOSOPHY assumes that healthy, well-functioning teeth will enhance your quality of living. We will work with you to achieve this goal by providing you with the finest and most current periodontal treatment available. We will make

every effort to provide this treatment in an environment that is as comfortable and pleasant as possible.

YOUR FIRST APPOINTMENT will consist of a review of your medical history and a thorough assessment of your periodontal tissues and their attachment to your teeth. Radiographs (x-rays) may be required to complete this assessment and will be taken if your referring dentist has not. Recommendations can then be made on the course that your therapy should take, including length of treatment and possible number of appointments. All courses of treatment will provide you with the education you need to care for your teeth, as the role you play is essential to keep your teeth your lifetime. Often, our treatment must work in concert with your general dentist to achieve the best possible dental health.

HOURS

Generally, the office is open Monday through Thursday from 8 am to 5 pm and Friday until 3 pm (with an occasional Monday or Friday off). Occasionally, we have meetings and continuing education seminars which will change these hours.
